Plumeria Winter Care Basics

Method #1: For Exposed-End Cuttings

- Callous with root hormone or with time as indicated on other side of this page
- Or wrap with crumpled newspaper
- Either of the above methods, store in a dark place in a box/bucket indoors

 OR
 - o Gang-root in 4-6 inches of Perlite, slightly damp
 - Store in a dark place in a box/bucket indoors; standing upright

Method #2: For Bag-Rooted Cuttings

- Pot it
- Place in a warm area indoors
- Minimum-to-no watering during the winter months

Taking Care of Cuttings

- Can be stored for winter (wrapped as is)
- Keep in warm indoor space in standing storage
- Bag-root or plant in February

Taking Care of Potted Plumeria Plants

- Keep in the pot until Spring
- Minimal water as we approach winter months
- . During dormant period NO fertilizer!
